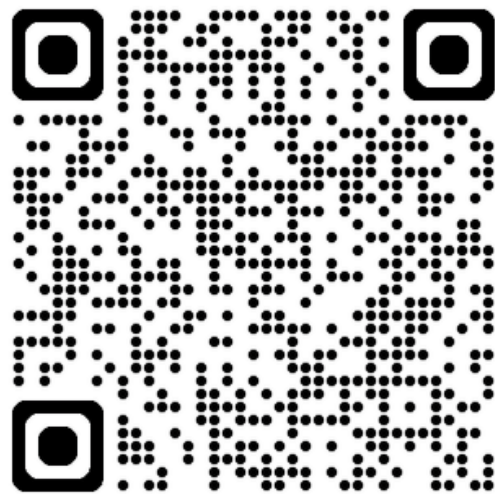

PARKING

Guests may park their vehicle on the driveway in front of this unit's garage door (**marked "A" below**) which accommodates two vehicles. Our garage space is only big enough to house the electric cruiser and beach gear

There are a number of community & HOA policies that you should remember to honor. Violations can result in fines that we will pass along to you.

- The garage door must remain closed unless the garage is being actively used to enter or exit the property.
- Parking around the resort pool is reserved for guests actively using the pool. Street parking in Prominence is prohibited.
- No RV, boat, or trailer parking is allowed in the community.
- Electric Cruisers are not allowed on any bike path

Please do not use parking spaces other than the space for this unit! These driveways belong to the residents and guests in those units respectively and are monitored via surveillance cameras and roving security. Unauthorized users of these driveways risk being towed.

The Electric Cruisers can only be parked in the garage or the driveway. Electric Cruisers that are parked on the sidewalks, streets, or greenspaces risk being towed. **We charge \$1000 for impounded vehicle retrieval.** Children or unlicensed drivers are never allowed to drive electric cruisers on any street in the Prominence community or on Hwy 30A per FL law.

CHECK-IN TIME: 4:00PM

We offer early check-in based on availability. Just reach out to me no more than 48 hours in advance and I'll check the schedule.



DOOR LOCK:

To unlock- enter the user code you were provided with your welcome message in the App

CHECK-OUT TIME: 10:00AM

To ensure our housekeepers have ample time to clean and sanitize the unit for the next guest, check-out time is no later than 10:00 a.m. We can occasionally accommodate late checkout, but need at least 48 hours notice to check the schedule for the next guests arrival. **We cannot guarantee late check-out.**

CHECK-OUT PROCESS



- Leave the beds unmade. No need to strip them
- Leave all towels on the floor in front of the laundry room
- Please load the dishes in the dishwasher. No need to start it.
- Empty all the trash and place it in the green trash bin in the Garage or at the curb.
- Please do not leave anything in the house, including trash or unopened food or drinks
- Just before you go, close all doors and windows and check that they are locked



If there have been any breakages or spills, or if anything didn't work properly, please let me know or leave a note on the kitchen table for the housekeeper. Accidents happen, and we don't charge for minor dings and the odd glass or plate, but if anything more substantial has happened please do contact me before you leave and we can agree on a charge.

PARKING

We have parking in front of our garage door (see parking section at front of this book). Overflow parking is hard to find. Do not park in any other home's parking spaces, you will be towed!

The HOA does not allow street parking. All vehicles must be parked in garages, driveways or the common gravel parking areas along the streets. Parking at mail kiosks is for 5-minute mail pickup/ Drop off parking only.



BICYCLES

Bicycles can't be secured to trees or parked in landscaped areas. Bikes will be stolen, please use the bike locks provided.



TOWELS/CLOTHES ON BALCONIES

Towels and clothes must NOT be draped over the balconies or porch railings per HOA rules. Grilling on Balconies:



GRILLS

The fire code prohibits the use and/or storage of grills, whether gas or charcoal, on balconies of connected homes/triplex/cluster and townhomes).



FIREWORKS

The use and discharge of fireworks is prohibited.



GARAGES

Garage doors must remain closed at all times except when entering or otherwise actively using the garage. Recreational vehicles, campers, and boats shall be parked in garages or stored out of view from the

Most electric cruisers in the area use the same key cut, and we've had issues where folks have taken the wrong electric cruiser from a parking lot near the beach or at a restaurant. We do not track you during your stay.

You may get alerts on your iPhone that there's an AirTag nearby.

Our tags are named **[Propertyname]-[licensePlate] Cart** -- e.g. **"Merry Way - BOBBI71 cart"** or **"Twickenham - SUZIE71 cart"**.



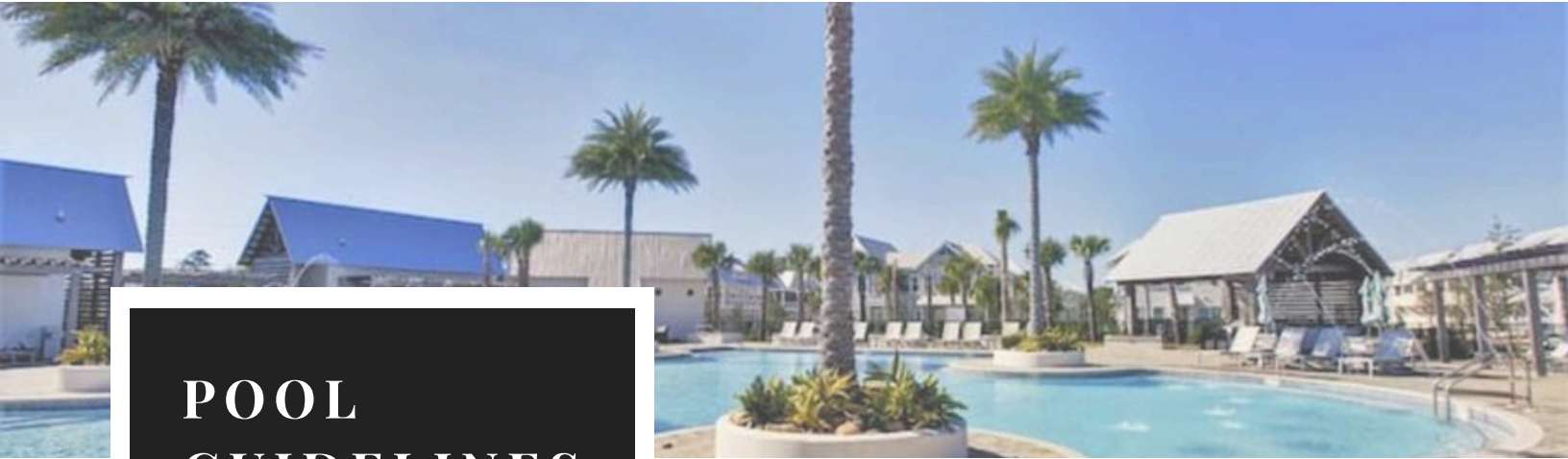

POOL GUIDELINES

Code to use pool: Provided in your welcome message

Hours of operation for the pool are **8:00 am to 9:00 pm**

*** Pool is heated to 85 degrees during March, April, October and November. ***

- No glass containers of any kind allowed inside the fenced pool area, this includes the grill area and tables.
- There is no lifeguard on duty; therefore you use the facility at your own risk.
- Children under 13 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- Children not yet potty trained must wear a swim diaper.
- Diving, rough play and running is not allowed.
- Complete pool rules are posted at the pool and must be followed.
- No floats in the pool, except children's safety flotation devices.

30A MAP

This is a map of our little beach community. Old Florida "State Road 30" once started at the Alabama state line and meandered 283 miles east across the panhandle. Several "alternate routes" (hence the "A" in 30A) offered drivers a slower scenic option, usually along the beach. But we don't think of 30A as disjointed miles of soulless asphalt. 30A® is a celebration of small town beach life – the kind that's been enjoyed by families for decades all along the Gulf Coast. 30A isn't just a line on the map. It's a lifestyle; an attitude. It's that happy place we all dream of when we need to unwind, unplug and celebrate life."

- Santa Rosa Beach and the surrounding area have some of the most beautiful beaches in the world. The best beaches in our opinion are the public beaches that are part of the national park system. They are generally not as crowded as the deeded beaches closer to some of the other communities. Our favorite beaches are below, but a large list can be found at <https://30a.com/category/beaches/>

PUBLIC BEACH RULES

- **Leave No Trace**– all items left on the beach overnight will be discarded to help maintain our pristine beaches and provide a safe environment for our South Walton Sea Turtles.
- **Vehicles** require a permit to drive onto the beach, and are only allowed to drive on the beach at Grayton Beach. Permits can be applied for through the Walton County Board of County Commissioners lottery system.
- **Dog Permits** are required for dogs on the beach, and are only available to residents of Walton County and/or property owners in Walton County. Those permits can also be purchased through the BCC. Permits are issued year round and expire on August 1st of each year.
- **Glass containers** are prohibited on the beach.
- **Stay off the dunes.**
- **Removal of sand**, water and vegetation is strictly prohibited.
- **Two 15' corridors are reserved for emergency vehicles**; one extending 15' from the dune toward the water, and the other extending 15' from the water's edge upland.
- **Amplified sound** (audio device, speakers, radio, musical instrument, etc.) which can be heard by a person using normal hearing faculties at a distance of 100 feet from the source of the sound is not permitted.
- **Tents** must be 10' x 10' or smaller and are to be set up only on the top 1/3 of the available beach space, still allowing for a 15' distance from the dunes for emergency vehicles.
- **Charcoal grills** are not allowed on the beach. All grilling must be done on Propane grills measuring at 225 square inches (approximately 12"x18" rectangular or 16" in diameter for circular grills) or smaller.
- **Bonfire permits** can be applied for through the South Walton Fire District, Monday through Friday from 8 until 4. All bonfires must be put out and cleaned up by 1 AM and remnants must not be placed in the TDC trash containers. Other Beach Safety Tips:

- For daily beach flag updates, text SAFETY to 31279.
- Under double red flag conditions, entering the water can result in a \$500 fine and criminal charges.
- Swim near a lifeguard! They are trained to keep you safe.
- If caught in a rip current, don't panic! Instead, float or swim parallel to shore.
- To watch educational videos from local lifeguards, scan the QR code.



Nearest Beaches



Deer Lake State Park

This state park is roughly half a mile away from the Prominence area (about a five-minute electric cruiser ride). Upon arrival, you will see a small parking lot that requires an entry fee of \$3 per vehicle (2 to 8 passengers) or \$2 per pedestrian/bicyclist/extra passengers. There is a long scenic boardwalk that brings you from the parking lot to the beach and is a five-to-ten minute walk. Be sure to get there early, as there is limited parking and they will close the entrance once it is full. Beach service is not provided here.



Walton Dunes

Located 2.5 miles from the Prominence area, Walton Dunes is an easily accessible beach entrance! Unlike Deer Lake, there are no stairs/ramps and you can walk right up to the beach. You take a left at Lakewood Drive and follow the curve until you see the parking lot for cars/Electric Cruisers. Beach service is the only amenity provided here.



Santa Clara

Santa Clara beach is located 3.5 miles from the Prominence area and doesn't have any stairs/ramps. This beach has parking, restrooms, beach service, and lifeguards during peak season. It is off Scenic 30A, 1/2 mile east of Scenic 395, and you turn south on Bramble Grove Place.



Gulf Lakes

Gulf Lakes is half a mile east of the Prominence area. This access point has bike parking, a freshwater shower, and beach service. There are no restrooms or car/electric cruiser parking.

BIKES

We provide bikes for your use during your stay with us. The property listing will tell you how many bikes are in each unit.

BIKES

Important: There is a tire gauge and bike pump in the garage. Bike tires can lose air over just a few days, so please check and pump the tires to no more than 40 psi before you take them out. Underinflated tires will greatly increase the amount of effort you have to exert to get around.

Guests are responsible for getting bikes back to the house and letting us know if there are any issues such as a flat tire while in use.

LOCK CODES: Our system will send you the lock codes a couple of days before you check in.



- Bikes will get stolen- Please use the locks provided when you take the bikes out for a joy ride. Bicycles can't be secured to trees or parked in landscaped areas.
- **Secure the bike through the frame- not the wheels!**

The electric cruiser has a high-density 60AH lithium battery.

Maximum range is approximately 40 miles on a full charge, and may be more or less based on the number of passengers, terrain, and how hard you push it.

ELECTRIC CRUISER RULES

- **Rules/ Regulations**

- This is a Florida State registered Low Speed Vehicle. All driving rules apply. Seat belts must be worn, turn signals used, and traffic signs obeyed. The electric cruiser is a LICENSED VEHICLE, just like an automobile.
- No one under the age of 25 is permitted to drive this Low-Speed Vehicle.
- All operators must have a valid driver's license and Insurance card to drive a electric cruiser in Florida. Under no conditions are you allowed to let another driver drive this vehicle who has not signed the release.
- Electric cruiser is only permitted on County Roads with a maximum speed of 25 miles per hour. Please pull over if a car is behind you Do not take electric cruiser on nature trails, native grass areas, etc.
- 4 Seat Electric Cruisers and 6 seat Electric Cruisers designate the maximum number of passengers. All passengers must be seated. NO CHILDREN ALLOWED IN DRIVERS LAP.
- Electric cruiser **must** be parked in the Garage when not in use. It will be fined/ towed if left on the side of the road, on the grass, or in another unit's parking space.
- Anyone observed abusing electric cruiser rules and regulations will forfeit all rental privileges immediately. This includes reckless driving, speeding, or allowing underage guests to operate the electric cruiser.
- You agree to pay for any damage to the electric cruiser & authorize us to charge your credit card for same.
- You further agree to pay for any costs we incur to collect for damages.
- It is strictly forbidden that a minor or any individual without a valid driver's license operate this vehicle. At no time may a minor have a hand or hands on the steering wheel when the vehicle is moving. This requires you to have possession/control of vehicle keys when not in use.

ELECTRIC CRUISER RULES

- The Electric Cruiser is a Low Speed Vehicle and is considered a "car" in Florida. That means you have to adhere to all traffic and parking laws just like your personal vehicle! Please see <https://waltonso.org/lsv/> for guidance and fines.
- If these are issued while you're away from the vehicle, they will be sent to us and we will pass them on to you for repayment.
- In order for us to release the LSV key to you when you arrive, you must have all parties that will be driving the LSV Electric Cruiser to execute the electric cruiser waiver, which is required by our insurance company before we can release the key to the Electric cruiser.
- Also, review the community rules regarding the electric cruisers and their usage. The Electric Cruiser is a Low-Speed Vehicle (LSV), titled in Florida. As such, there are a number of requirements regarding the age of the operator (≥ 25 yrs), insurance coverage, and safety rules. Please review and digitally sign the Electric Cruiser Waiver here at least 1 week prior to check-in.
- We also need a photocopy of your driver's License and Proof of Insurance sent to me as outlined in the waiver.
- **FINES** - The community HOA and the Walton County Sheriff's Department WILL issue fines for Electric cruiser violations. We will pass these along to you if they occur. The Fines are as follows:
 - **Unlicensed/Underage Driver \$100.00 - DRIVERS MUST BE 25 or older - NO EXCEPTIONS**
 - **Running a Stop Sign/Speeding \$100.00**
 - **Non-Approved Rental Electric Cruiser \$100.00**
 - **Unsafe Operation \$100.00 - Overloaded Vehicle \$100.00**

If WCSO issues the fine, it is \$500 to the parent of the child who is driving. There have been many accidents with young teens driving electric cruisers and this is why they are being banned in surrounding communities. We need electric cruisers in our community. We don't want this to happen to us.

** PLEASE watch this 4-minute video from the Walton County Sheriff's office. It will help you avoid citations and maximize safety. You are responsible for any violations and citations during your use of the vehicle. We will charge guests \$1000 to recover the LSV if it's impounded.

That's where 30A's abundance of local guides and tour services come into play, as well as attractions you'll only find in 30A! Read on below to learn more about the unique and awesome experiences you can have in 30A!



Coastal Dune Lakes

30A is famous for its incredible phenomenon of coastal dune lakes. These are so rare that there are only four countries in the world where they occur! In the U.S., you can only find coastal dune lakes along the Gulf Coast and in one single pocket in Oregon, with fifteen of the nation's coastal dune lakes all located in South Walton and the 30A area. These gorgeous lakes have been around for as long as ten thousand years! This exotic wetland is from sand being redistributed by the wind to create shallow basin lakes teeming with verdant greenery and wildlife.



Eden Gardens

This serene park is Nestled along the shores of Choctawhatchee Bay and the Tucker Bayou. It spans over the course of one hundred and twenty-four acres in the middle of South Walton. Check out the public grounds for a particularly wonderful experience.



Longleaf Greenway Trail

This extensive eight-mile-long trail runs from west to east through the Point Washington State Forest, with primary access to the trail located along County Road 395 at Eastern Lake. The trailhead has ample parking and picnic tables. Parking costs \$2.00 per person for day-use parking, with children under the age of six admitted for free. Annual passes are also available for as little as \$30.00 at the Point Washington State Forest field office. The trail is named for the Longleaf pine trees that once dominated the landscape of the South.

LIBATIONS



Red Bar

If there's one must-try destination in 30A, it's unanimously Red Bar. Locals and visitors alike flock to this one-of-a-kind Grayton Beach destination for its delicious eats and its incredible nightlife. You're bound to spot a celebrity or two while enjoying amazing live jazz music from the house band. Chow down on shrimp pasta, hearty chicken, and spicy crawfish in this eclectic watering hole.



Shades Bar & Grill

A 30A destination location for more than 20 years, Shades Bar & Grill continues to turn friends into family! With daily chef features, famous wings, classic spirits and a fabulous staff, Shades is the place to meet and eat on 30A.



Old Florida Fish House

Located in the heart of Seagrove Beach, Old Florida Fish House prides itself in providing a family friendly, casual dining experience serving daily Gulf fresh seafood specials, select steaks and the best sushi on 30A. Old Florida Fish House's guests are invited to sip mouthwatering cocktails or an ice cold brew and dine inside or outdoors. The Oyster Bar, more fondly known as the locals' hidden gem, features a full-service bar, big screen TV's, the freshest oysters on 30A, and panoramic views of Eastern Lake. Old Florida Fish House has proudly featured local and national live music, special events, and South Walton's most sought-after dining experience.

GOLF

30A is a fantastic destination for golf enthusiasts. Current list of golf courses can be found here: Bikes will get stolen- Please use the locks provided when you take the bikes out for a joy ride. Bicycles can't be secured to trees or parked in landscaped areas. A great golf booking consolidator is here

- **Regatta Bay** This 6,894-yard, par-72 semi-private course is located just a few minutes away from 30A in Destin. The Regatta Bay Golf Course is nestled within nature preserves, so your views here include magnificent trees and the beautiful Choctawhatchee Bay. The greens themselves overlook gorgeous lakes lined with pine. It's common to see beautiful birds soaring overhead as you play here! About an hour from the unit.
- **Kelly Plantation Golf Course** The semi-private Kelly Plantation Golf Course features 18 holes spanning 7,099 yards. Overlooking Choctawhatchee Bay, this course is rated almost five stars and is in the top 5% of all golf courses in America (per Golf Digest). It's not uncommon to see dolphins splashing in the distance as you play this course!
- **Camp Creek Golf Club** Camp Creek Golf Club is tucked away and feels very much like a hidden gem. This public golf course near Rosemary Beach was designed by famed golf course architect Tom Fazio. It features 7,200-yards of fairways that complement the surrounding natural scenery. - **Shark's Tooth Golf Club** Located alongside Lake Powell, Florida's largest coastal dune lake, Shark's Tooth Golf Club offers an incredible golf experience. Coastal dune lakes are rare ecosystems found only in a few places around the world, so this spot is special. Shark's Tooth is one of the few golf courses in Florida that boasts the Silver Sanctuary Signature Status Award by Audubon International. Immerse yourself in nature as you play this course; it stretches 7,209 yards from the back tees. These fairways feature views of Lake Powell, oaks, pines, and wooden bridges. 20 minutes from unit, watersound members only.
- **Origins Golf Club** The Origins Golf Club was designed by another renowned course architect, Davis Love III. It stretches approximately 1,800 yards along Florida's Emerald Coast and is built upon "a spirit of relaxed refinement." Fantastic views abound as you play this course.
- **Santa Rosa Golf Club** Santa Rosa Golf Club is the only member-owned golf course and private beach club along scenic Highway 30A. It hugs South Walton's white sandy beaches and overlooks the turquoise waters of the Gulf. At Santa Rosa, you will find an 18-hole, par-72 championship golf course. It is also a member of Audubon International and has been described as having "the purest golf in the Florida panhandle" by Golf Magazine.

THINGS TO DO

Deer Lake State Park

Unlike other seaside destinations, the Gulf Coast is renowned for its calm, clear waters and gentle waves. While this spells dismal surfing conditions, the water is just right for stand-up paddle boarding, a leisurely yet invigorating sport that is often easier and more enjoyable than surfing. Go paddle boarding in the Gulf of Mexico, or at one of the many coastal dune lakes that dot Highway 30A.

Eastern Lake Bike & Hike Trail

At the easternmost end of Point Washington State Forest, you'll encounter the beautiful coastal dune lake known as Eastern Lake. Pay the \$2.00 per person fee to enter and you'll be rewarded with stunning views. You can bike or hike your way around this unique lake's landscape of coastal pines, cypress ponds, sandhills, flatwoods, and wet prairies. Keep an eye out for extraordinary local wildlife, from alligators to deer and coyotes.

THINGS TO DO

Sculpt Studio

Keep in beach-body shape with the help of the experts at Sculpt Studio! They offer yoga-based classes incorporating light weights and cardio. They frequently host classes on The Hub stage, so make sure to keep an eye out for their class schedule!

Timpoochee Trail and Point Washington State Forest

Timpoochee Trail is an eighteen-mile-long trail that runs the entire length of Highway 30A. This allows you to embrace the small-town atmosphere of 30A while enjoying a leisurely bike ride across multiple beach towns. Being up close rather than in the seat of a car, allows you to see what makes 30A so wonderful! The trail also diverts into the gorgeous Point Washington State Forest along the Eastern Lake Trail, where you can tailor your adventure to a three-mile, five-mile, or ten-mile loop.

See Truman's Hometown in Seaside

As we mentioned before, the quaint and charming town of Seaside served as the "too good to be true" setting of the iconic Jim Carrey movie, *The Truman Show*. The combination of pastel houses, white picket fences, and charming cobblestone streets make the town famous for its nostalgic perfectionism. Spend the day perusing through the adorable boutiques and treat yourself to a sunset dinner at Bud and Alley's. End your night with a movie or theater performance under the twinkling stars at Seaside Amphitheater or Seaside Repertory Theater.

Fishing on the Emerald Coast

30A is renowned for its incredible, record-breaking sport fishing that draws in anglers from across the globe. While there aren't any harbors in 30A, you can rent out a fishing charter in Grayton Beach and embark on a deep sea fishing adventure to catch blackfin tuna, mahi mahi, grouper, wahoo, red snapper, flounder, and more. You can alternatively fish from the shore to catch pompano, redfish, and speckled trout along the beach or Choctawhatchee Bay.

Grayton Beach State Park

Home to an expansive two thousand acres of park land, Grayton Beach State Park has something for everyone. You can fish, canoe, or kayak on Western Lake, or go hiking or biking through the incredible coastal forests. You won't want to miss this lovely state park!
